The Master of Arts in Christian Leadership (MACL) provides hands-on, pragmatic application of complex theological truths. Relevant to those in both ministry and market-place, this degree offers training in leadership, administration, and conflict management alongside core biblical principles. Its design also qualifies a missionary candidate whose sending agency requires a year of graduate theological education for appointment. This degree may be completed fully online, partially online, or in the classroom.
