WHEREAS, In order to better protect the interest, safety, and belongings of those in the residence hall who earn scholarships and/or pay for their residency, this Government finds this recommendation pertinent; and,

WHEREAS, While the college has been gracious enough to keep the student residents in mind by putting security personnel on campus, this Government finds that occurrences still indeed happen on campus; and,

WHEREAS, Many students have faces situations where their vehicles are broken into and situations where non-Criswell people have found their way into Lance's Hall; and,

WHEREAS, These situations pose a legitimate threat to the students who reside in Lance's Hall; and,

WHEREAS, The recommendation made by this Government states that there be a written policy for on-campus security personnel, stating that there will be personnel on-campus as long as residents are present; and therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, The Student Government Association of Criswell College supports The Written Policy for On-Campus Security; and therefore,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the President, Vice-President, and the Speaker of the House shall advocate for this bill; and therefore,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be sent to The President, The Vice President, The Speaker of the House, The Judiciary, and The Student Services Office.
