H.B. 1.10: A Bill to Amend Article V. of the Constitution and Clarify Term Limits For Supreme Court Appointee's

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the term limits for those members who have been appointed by the President and approved by the House of Representative to serve on the Supreme Court and approved. This bill comes in light of the ambiguity regarding the duration of time an appointee of the Supreme Court will stay and serve. The Bill proposes that the appointees will serve a full academic year in their appointed positions.
