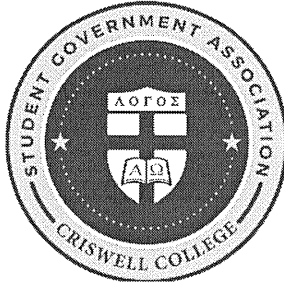


Executive Summary

H.B. 1.7: A Bill to Recommend that Students Are Made More Aware of Safety Procedures, Measures and Protocols

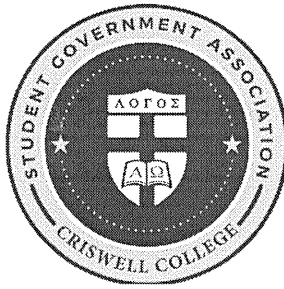
WHEREAS, Members of Criswell College should be made more aware of the safety procedures, measures and protocols; **AND**
