WHEREAS, The Purpose of this bill is to clarify the Process of Disciplinary Actions for House Representatives; more specifically those who fail to meet the requirements as specified in Section Four of the Constitution, House Bill 1.8 and House Bill 2.3.

WHEREAS, If a Representative fails to meet the requirements specified, they will first receive a written warning. These warnings will be issued by the Speaker of the House; and,

WHEREAS, If they Fail to comply with standards, after receiving two warnings, they will receive a Letter of Censure, from both the Speaker of the House and the President; and,

WHEREAS, The House Representative will also be subject to the process of impeachment, or a letter of removal from the Supreme Court. In this matter the Speaker and President must by letter officially request a letter of removal from the Supreme Court. Within one week upon receiving this letter the Supreme Court must hold a hearing with the Speaker and President. In this hearing the Speaker and President must provide supporting documentation that proves negligence and or lack of action and or failure to meet the standards of a House Representative on behalf of the House Representative at question.
