- WHEREAS,** It is necessary that members of the S.G.A. meet 3 times a semester with a representative outside of their class. And
- WHEREAS,** In order to promote collegiality and fraternity between the representatives of each class. And
- WHEREAS,** It is crucial for S.G.A. members to meet and cooperate with one another for the common good of each class and the common good of the student body as a whole. And
- BE IT RESOLVED,** All members of the S.G.A. must meet 3 times a semester with a representative outside of their class, and
- BE IT RESOLVED,** They must notify the Speaker of the House in writing of their meeting before the final week of the semester ; and therefore
- BE IT RESOLVED,** Failure to meet this requirement may lead to termination of their position; unless an exemption granted by the Speaker ; and therefore
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That a copy of this act be sent to the Student Government President, The Speaker of the House, Supreme Court, as well as House members.
