



## Peacemakers Scholarship

### Applicant Qualifications:

- Applicant must have a demonstrated history of Christian Leadership.
- Applicant must be a first-time or transfer undergraduate or graduate student enrolled in a degree seeking program.
- Applicant must apply for all Federal Title IV aid and Institutional aid through the FAFSA and Criswell Supplemental Application.
- Applicant must meet all admission requirements and enter college in good academic standing.
- Applicant must meet all eligibility requirements listed in eligibility section.

### Eligibility Requirements

- Recipient must submit a letter of need with future plans/goals after receiving their college education and how that will impact their calling to ministry to be graded by admissions counselor with rubric and reviewed by Director of Admissions.
- Recipient must submit an annual church recommendation letter from designated church official for renewal awards.
- Recipient must submit a Scholarship Thank You Letter to donors.
- Recipient must enroll full-time (12 Hours for Undergraduate, 9 for Graduate).
- Recipient must meet the appropriate minimum cumulative GPA for their program and a pace of progression of at least 67%.
  - a. 2.0 GPA for BABS, BACM, BAPSY, and BAPPE / 2.75 for BSED
  - b. 2.5 for MACL, MACS, MDIV / 2.75 for MATBS

### Scholarship Parameters:

- Undergraduate (Stackable with other scholarships not to exceed 100% of tuition and fees)
  - On Campus - \$9,500 per year / \$38,000 total
  - Off Campus - \$6,500 per year / \$26,000 total
- Graduate (Stackable with other scholarships not to exceed 100% of tuition and fees)
  - On Campus - \$8,000 per year / \$16,000 total
  - Off Campus - \$5,000 per year / \$10,000 total

### Terms and Conditions:

- Recipient must complete registration process within 14 days of scholarship offer.
- Recipient must maintain continuous full-time enrollment.
- Scholarship awarded for Fall and Spring terms only (No Summer Awards).
- Recipient must meet all student responsibilities and conduct rules as outlined in the student handbook and the academic catalog to remain in good standing.
